Seasoned by the elements after a lifetime at sea, the timber used in each tile is up to a century old, possessing an incredible resilience and rich character. And since the quantities of reclaimed hardwood available are finite, these timber tiles are even more exclusive. Now lovingly crafted into mosaic form, they can be used internally on walls and ceilings and for some external applications.

The tiles come in two sizes – 300 x 300mm and 600 x 300mm – and two distinct finishes, both suited to a diverse range of interior styles.

Rustico is a naturally finished, minimally treated range that allows the honest, natural spirit of the timber to shine through – perfect for relaxed interiors with an organic aesthetic.





Silva is a polished, refined treatment of the same hardwood with understated elegance and perfect for high-end projects where sleek lines and premium finishes reign supreme. The warmth and beauty of the timber grain provides a stunning contrast to modern, man-made synthetic surfaces.
